

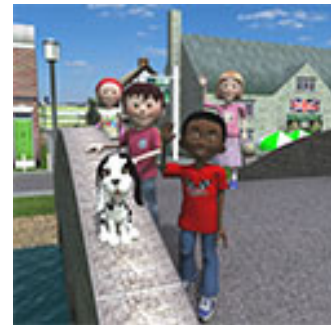
Written by an award winning children’s author\*, experienced linguist and teacher trainer, Little Bridge is created to captivate its young audience – and to inspire them to learn.
